

International Center Services

The staff of the International Center will coordinate all aspects of your hospital stay, helping to ensure that you and your family are comfortable and that your concerns are addressed.

Our comprehensive and personalized services are described below.

Medical Care Arrangements International Center Staff will:

■ Arrange a referral to the physician whose clinical expertise best meets your needs.

Schedule all necessary appointments and diagnostic procedures, as well as coordinate any necessary

> support services throughout your hospital experience. All appointments are confirmed via phone, fax, or e-mail.

• Meet with you and your family upon your arrival at HSS for treatment and remain in constant contact throughout your stay.

■ Visit you after your procedure and continue to act as a liaison between you and your physician to address any issues or concerns that may arise post-operatively.

Regularly check on your progress and make sure you know where to go for physical therapy and other post-operative care throughout your recovery process.

Financial Services

Our staff will provide an estimate of treatment costs and can assist in coordinating payment, wiring money from home, and managing the relevant financial aspects of your hospital visit. A financial analyst will explain the details of your estimate and your final bill and will answer any questions you may have.

Multilingual Staff

International Center staff members speak several languages and can serve as interpreters. HSS Language Assistance Services also provide skilled medical interpreters to assist you and your family during your time at the hospital. Interpreters will accompany you to your appointments to ensure you fully understand your medical care. Please let us know in advance if you need an interpreter. Medical interpreter services during your hospital stay are provided free of charge.

Accommodations

The Belaire Guest Facility is conveniently located across from the hospital. The Belaire offers comfortable lodging for patients and their families. Studio, one- and two-bedroom units can be combined to offer suites that will accommodate up to six guests. Each unit has a fullservice kitchenette, full bath, and a living room/seating area, as well as telephone and television services. The facility has 24-hour security and each room has an intercom to the main lobby. We are happy to make a reservation at the Belaire upon request.

Transportation

The International Center can arrange for car service between the airport and hospital upon request. You can also hail yellow cabs which are easy to find around the hospital and at all airports. We can assist you in hailing a yellow cab near the hospital.


